Description: The magazine Medical Affairs, Volume II, Nos. 1 and 2 (Spring, 1961), published by the University of Pennsylvania School, is a special issue, "The School of Medicine and the Civil War," and contains several references to North Carolina.

The map is of Vance, Warren, Franklin, and Granville counties by John E. Buck, Henderson, N. C., 1927.

An Industrial Survey of Louisburg, Franklin County, North Carolina is a thirty-three page mimeographed report with an index. A "History of Education in Franklin County" is Julius A. Woodward's sixty-nine page thesis for a Master's degree at Wake Forest College. It contains information on the formation of the county, the academies, the Literary Fund, public education prior to 1860 and from 1868-1914, and county organization, 1914-1932. "The Slaves of my Childhood" by Walter Alexander Montgomery, a fifty-eight page typescript, has chapters on slavery and the Civil War.
