Description: This roll book of slaves begins with a notation "Age of Negroes taken from a Register in Mr Edw^d Frank's own Hand Writing by W. A." The earliest recorded birth is 1766 and the birth records continue into 1864. There are lists of taxable slaves belonging to W. Avery, 1809-1818, conveyance of slaves from W. Avery to Isaac Avery, 1813. One memorandum lists land grants and acreage on "Big Creek of Tuckasejah" and another is titled "Slaves which W. Avery intends to permit the Profits to be applied to support his Daughter P. Nine and her Children."
