Physical Description: Newspaper clippings, letters, and printed orders in scrapbooks. 2 bound volumes.

Acquisition:

Description: These scrapbooks contain a mixture of newspaper clippings for the Civil War years and a later period, some items dated as late as 1920. There are also a few printed items - bulletins from the State Convention and the governor's office, as well as some manuscript notes. Newspaper clippings and excerpts (manuscript) from General Orders from the Adjutant General's office show the formation of regiments from voluntary State troops and handwritten notes on the same pages of the clippings indicate promotions, deaths in battle, etc. In the latter years of the war the clippings list casualties, accounts of battles, sketches of battlefields, and reminiscences. Those of a later period relate DAR activities and some sketches of outstanding North Carolinians including Edwin Wiley Fuller (poet and novelist), Henry Toole Clark, William Dorsey Pender, Thomas Jordan Jarvis, William R. Cox, and Albert Sydney Johnston.

A loose item in one of the scrapbooks is a letter from Kenneth Rayner to Governor Clark, Raleigh, June 18, 1862, describing his taking President Jefferson Davis to catch a train from Raleigh to Weldon.



PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: 115 items--genealogical charts (in varying states of completion)

HISTORY AND DESCRIPTION: These charts and partial charts were created by Governor Clark prior to his death in 1874 and were intended to trace the various families from which he and his wife were sprung or to whom they were connected by ties of blood and marriage. The first eighteen folders are shelved with the oversize Private Collection materials, and the nineteenth folder is filed in the map case drawers holding double oversize Private Collection materials.
