Description: Commission as major, 6th Regiment of Volunteers, Militia, State of Connecticut, February 22, 1865. Note on reverse, Headquarters, Department of North Carolina, Army of Ohio, Wilmington, North Carolina, March 7, 1865, stating Grant mustered into service as major of the 6th Connecticut Infantry. Commission signed by William McKinley to Grant as additional paymaster of volunteers, June 8, 1898. Certificates of membership as Companion of the First Class of Military Order of the Loyal Legion of the United States, Philadelphia, December 31, 1902.
