Description: The manuscript copy of Major General Greene's orders, dated March 16, 1781, "Speedwell Furnis on a branch of New River," commends behavior in action the previous day of Colonels Washington and Lee, Generals Stephens and Lawson, the Virginia Militia and the First Maryland Regiment. The other order is copy of an "arrangement" of the first and third regiments of the Light Dragoons, by order of the Honble Major General Greene, November 9, 1782, by Anty Wayne, B. G.
