These include: Major Henry Baker, Isle of Wight County, Virginia (1645-1712), Colonel Henry Baker, Chowan Precinct, North Carolina (____-1738), Major John Baker, Hertford County (1726-1784), member of the State senate, and Simon Baker, John Baker, and George Baker.

S. G. Baker, "Traditions and recollections of the Baker Family of which I am a member," (Scotland Neck, North Carolina, Februray 4, 1847), an eight-page typescript from the original, gives information on Colonel Benjamin Baker and Lawrence Baker of Smithville, James River.

Description: William Sharpe to the Lords of the Committee of the Council for Plantation Affairs at the Council Chamber, Whitehall, July 13, 1747, concerns the complaint of the Palatines dispossession by Thomas Pollock and their petition for restoration of their property.

The Petition of the Palatines in North America to King George II. explains the terms upon which they came to America under the guardianship of de Graffenried, tells of the Indian wars and Pollock's desertion of them to the mercy of the Indians and later return to take their lands, and lists the petitioners.
