Description: The deeds convey the lands and slaves of Willis, William, James, David, and Curtis Thompson of Sampson County. One deed is between Jefferson Judd and Thomas Hunter of Moore County, and another carries the notation that it traces the "Osborne family." Other items include an account of sale of goods by Willis Thompson, June 16, 1827, and a letter from James Faison, Sampson Courthouse, to James King, Rutherford, Tennessee, December 20, 1815.
