Physical Description: 6 items: outgoing letters (negative photocopies).

Acquisition: April 13, 1964, letters written by Rob[er]t Palmer, 1764, from Edenton and Bath to Neil [Neal] Jamison, Norfolk [Virginia]. 6 letters, negative photocopies. Given by Hon. Herbert C. Bonner, Washington, D. C.

Description: In these letters, written from Edenton and Bath, May-December 1764, Robert Palmer attempts to settle a debt owed to Neil Jamison, a merchant of Norfolk, Virginia. Palmer expresses regret in the delay in payment; offers to give Jamison, as payment, a vessel he has on stocks; and finally notifies him that payment has been sent to settle part of the debt.
