damages due with notation by Penn (1784); bond of Joseph W. Taylor
and John Penn to Richard Caswell (1785); memorandum relative to
Orondotte Davis' estate (1786); note from John Penn to Reuben
Leary, January 15, 1787, giving instructions relative to a
judgment; and a deed of gift from John Penn to his son William
Penn for land on both sides of Tar River and Table's Creek,
Granville County (1788).
